Jacket and tie are optional. For Dance, they should have black jazz pants with appropriate undergarments, the appropriate shoes based on the style of dance, and a white t-shirt</li> <li>o Women should have a nice knee-length or full skirt, dress shoes, and a nice looking blouse. Full dresses and pant suits are optional. For dance, they should have a full black leotard with the appropriate undergarments and the appropriate shoes based on the style of dance.</li> </ul> </li> </ul> <p><b>Dance Classes</b></p> <p>Students are required to dress for all dance classes.
